Musa Njuguna Kenya, East Africa.....6

Bishop Musa heard the gospel for the first time at a revival and accepted Christ as his Savior. After finishing college, Dr. Njuguna, worked to put his brothers and sisters through school. He began to feel burdened for church planting and evangelism in the nation of Kenya and the East African region. Supported primarily by GTCOTR, Dr. Njuguna now has a team of 15 full time ministers and has planted 270+ churches among more than 21 different tribes. This year Reverend Musa celebrated 45 years of ministry.

RHM is an extension ministry of Golden Triangle Church on the Rock through which many of the Church’s missions and outreach programs are both funded and marketed to a broader audience. Contributions given through RHM go 100% to the project as designated by the giver.

COTR Food Pantry Port Arthur, TX.....8

The Food Pantry is a benevolent and evangelistic ministry to Southeast Texas communities distributing food and other household necessities. Supported by GTCOTR for the last 14 years, the Pantry is located at 649 Stadium Road in Port Arthur.



The Pantry is open Tuesday and Wednesday each week from 7:00-9:00 a.m. Over the last year, the Pantry has distributed goods to over 3,500 households. Many of those coming to the Pantry accept Christ and receive prayer and counsel from the Food Pantry volunteers.

Johanis Ciandy Papua, Indonesia.....9

Johanis is a GTCOTR supported missionary and a graduate of Christ for the Nations in Dallas, Texas. Johanis interned here before returning to his home country to begin missions work and youth outreach in a primarily Muslim area. Together with another ministry, Johanis has opened an outreach community center for families in the city of Merauke. Recently he had 22 Muslim families attend an outreach, some of whom came to Christ. This summer, 137 youth attended his youth camp, 64 were born again and 70 recommitted to live for the Lord.



Tej Rokka *Kathmandu, Nepal*.....11

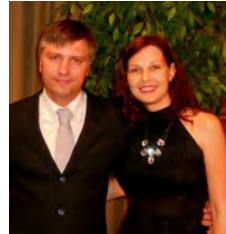
Pastor Tej was born and raised an orthodox Hindu in the shadow of Mount Everest. He accepted Christ while living at an orphanage after the death of his mother. Presently he is the senior pastor of SARA Church on the Rock in Kathmandu, and oversees multiple churches, SARA Training Center and SARA Children's Homes.



GTCOTR supports the Training Center, which to date has trained and graduated 67 church planters, pastors, evangelists, and church leaders. This summer our Vacation Bible School program raised \$4,400 for the orphanages. Members of our church also made numerous hand-made quilts for the orphans.

Pastor Sergey Gorokhov *Yoshkar-Ola & Kazan, Russia*.....13

In the summer of 1993, a team of 38 people left GTCOTR for Russia where they conducted evangelistic street meetings and evening crusades. Hundreds received Christ and Yoshkar-Ola Christian Center (YOCC) began. Pastor Sergey was converted in the early days of these first meetings. Today, YOCC is a thriving and regionally influential church. Last year Pastor Sergey installed another pastor in YOCC, and moved his family to the city of Kazan to begin a new church. Kazan has Russia's largest concentration of Muslims. This year Dr. and Mrs. Hammonds visited Pastor Sergey and taught many hundreds of pastors and leaders in churches and conferences in a number of strategic cities in Russia, including Yoshkar-Ola and Kazan.

Agua Resources International Water Well Drilling Ministry.....14

Agua Resources was founded by GTCOTR and has been bringing pure drinking water to those in need since 1998. Around the world, one in six people have no access to safe water. Cholera, giardia, and typhoid are the chief waterborne diseases, causing at least 4000 child deaths per day worldwide. Agua has drilled over 225 successful wells throughout the Atoyac and Costa Chica regions in Mexico in villages that were otherwise lacking a clean water supply. Agua Resources, in partnership with GTCOTR, has also funded wells in Kenya, Ghana, and the Philippines.

**Mike and Jude Kelly Philippines.....15**

Sent out by GTCOTR and working with the GTONATIONS missions agency, the Kellys conduct medical outreaches, work in community health and development, teach leaders and missionaries in training, and help street children through the Sonshine Center. These children live in what are called "squatter" villages, and many must sort through the city dump to find food to survive. The Kellys are also working with more than 500 families living in a developing village area. The Kellys recently played a major role in seeing a new medical clinic open up in their city this summer.

**Ralph and Annie Dryden Thailand17**

The Drydens are missionaries in Prakhonchai, which is located in Northeast Thailand. Their base is "The Church of God's Favor" pastored by Pastor Oong. The church's amazing growth over the past four years has required the training of many new leaders. Last year GTCOTR helped build a radio station that currently broadcasts the gospel throughout Thailand, and into Cambodia and Laos. The Drydens also continue to teach in regional Bible schools and minister in many Asian countries including Vietnam and Nepal.

Iran TV (RH111) "Postcards from the Bible" in Farsi **\$250**

RHM has been afforded a unique opportunity through Iran TV to broadcast the latest Postcards from the Bible television series four times each week to an estimated cumulative audience of 20 million Farsi speaking viewers living in the Middle East, North Africa, and Eastern Europe. Iranians in the 21st century are desperate to be



connected to the outside world. Just listen to this quote from Zari, a viewer of Iran Alive Ministries, "I am calling to say how grateful I am for your programs. I was devastated and lost in my misery until I started watching your programs."



The cost for airing each program has already been funded; however, in order to get each program translated into Farsi an additional \$250 per program is needed.

You can become a part of this solution by giving \$250 to provide translation of one 30 minute program. The translation of these programs into other languages creates greater opportunity to reach the masses who have been formerly hidden in an Islamic dominated world behind the language barrier.

Once translated, each program will continue to be made available to the Farsi speaking population of the world without further cost for generations to come.

Sound System (J111)**\$2,350**

This system will be used specifically for youth camp events. Up until now we have been renting a system, but it will be more cost effective to own one allowing us to use the rental money towards camp scholarships for students as this ministry continues to grow.

Music Scholarships (J211)**\$120 each**

A number of the student leaders who have been working with our youth camps will graduate this year leaving holes in our worship team. We would like to send 5 of our up and coming musicians to a three month training course to ensure that they are prepared for this next season of ministry.

**Filing Cabinet (J311)****\$225**

This basic storage facility will be used for the Merauke Community Center to ensure that proper records are kept secure and organized as we minister to numerous families and lead many to the Lord.

**Toiletries for Orphans (J411)****\$3 each**

Many children in this area do not even receive their most basic needs. For only \$3 we will provide them with a “necessities” kit containing things such as soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, and other important tools for basic hygiene.



We hope to purchase 100 of these kits to hand out.

It only costs \$8 to buy 1 sack of rice that will feed an orphan in the Merauke area for 2 weeks. We are asking for a total of 100 sacks to supply food throughout the winter season.

Bicycle for a Pastor (T111)**\$90 each**

Ninety percent of the pastors and evangelists that graduate from our Bible school go to work in the remote countryside where there is very limited public transportation. These men and women walk for hours, and sometimes days, going from village to village witnessing and working their ministries. We would like to give 10 bicycles as Christmas gifts to those who have worked very hard to make sure the gospel goes forth. Bicycles move missionaries!

**Water Baptism Tank (T211)****\$200 each**

In Nepal, public propagation of Christianity and water baptism are illegal. When someone does choose to get baptized it is a public sign that a person has denounced all other gods and committed his life to Jesus. We are currently travelling far distances to baptize many people in filthy rivers. We would like to build baptism tanks in five cities which would serve 100 local churches.

**Public Restroom Project (T311)****\$300 each**

Sanitary and health issues are of major concern in Nepal. There are few public restrooms, so oftentimes people relieve themselves in places where the contaminants continue the cyclic spread of sickness and disease. We would like to build 20 public toilets around our village, benefitting more than 500 families. These would be a blessing to our community from our church.

Goat Sharing Project (T411)

This is a true gift “from the Stable.” Being a pastor does not pay enough money to support a family in Nepal making it very difficult to spend enough time pastoring and teaching. He must continue to work long hours to provide even the basics for his family.



We would like to buy 10 goats to give to families so that they can raise the goat and make money off of its milk and offspring. Each family will be then asked to donate one of its baby goats to another pastor’s family so that the project will actually multiply.

Hindu orphans and widows have absolutely no help or hope for the future. I would like to take some time out during this Christmas season to show them that there is One who loves them and gave His life for them. \$350 each

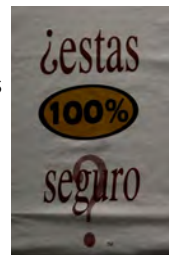

The shallow well pump is an excellent manual hand pump for villages without electricity. This PVC pump is lightweight and transportable. It is also highly effective, and able to deliver between 5-8 gallons per minute.

Team members take time during each trip to hand out gospel tracts and other evangelistic materials to adults and children in the villages where they are drilling. Gifts like our "RU100%SURE?" gospel tract in the Spanish language will help to bring living water to those who thirst spiritually as well as physically.
